

## ONLINE ACADEMIC WRITING WORKSHOP & FOLLOW-UP COACHING

This online workshop is for researchers and graduate students who wish to publish research articles in English. This course consists of two, 3-hour interactive, online teaching sessions covering the key aspects needed for writing a good academic paper. These sessions will be held in small groups of up to 9 participants.

### Follow-up Coaching

Participants will receive individual feedback on their writing (up to 1,500 words) following the course. The follow-up coaching will take place over email and zoom.

### AIM

The aim of this workshop is to improve the style and structure of participants' English academic papers and improve their confidence when writing research articles.

### FORMAT

2 online teaching sessions (suggestion: from 9.30 – 12:30). Participants will then have the opportunity to work in their own time and send a sample of their writing to the trainer for correction and feedback (up to 1,500 words). Texts should be sent to the instructor, ideally in MS Word format. Participants will receive corrected text and a chance to meet over Zoom to discuss their text, their writing goals, and ask questions. A detailed handout and workbook is also provided.

**STRUCTURE** 2 x three-hour online training sessions via Zoom, followed by texts sent to instructor for feedback. Feedback is given via email and in an online meeting.

**PREPARATION:** Participants should have a reasonable internet connection and have downloaded Zoom. In addition, for the second session, participants should have to hand a sample research article from their field. This should be something they have enjoyed reading or consider an example of a well-written paper.
