Advantages:

- Free allocation of learning time

Requirements:

Structure and content:

- Reading comprehension, listening comprehension, writing skills, language skills, regional studies, grammar and vocabulary
- Oral expression and social interaction synchronously via Zoom

Concept:

- Weekly workload: 4 hours of self-study, 2 hours of synchronous and interactive learning time via Zoom, 2 hours of tutored self-study and 2 hours for homework
- Duration: 12 weeks
- Passing requirement: at least 70% attendance, verified by using lesson tests and regular participation in the synchronous units
- German in practice → city excursion: discover Cologne
- Final exam: Online in the competence areas of listening and reading
