Aim	<p>To improve the style and structure of the participants' English academic papers. To give writers confidence in structuring and writing academic texts in English. Following the workshop, the participants will have a better understanding of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• cultural differences in academic texts• introducing a narrative into an academic text• structuring an English academic paper, paragraph and sentence• avoiding classic mistakes in written academic English• punctuating an English text• using specific academic vocabulary• writing abstracts and titles• working with AI and other online tools to correct texts• finding your voice• learning from native speaker papers• editing their your own work including concise writing

The workshop will contain information on structuring an English language paper and abstract, vocabulary and punctuation, cultural differences in academic papers, the writing process, finding a narrative and tools and resources for improving one's written English. To get the most out of the workshop, participants should bring a short text they have written themselves for peer review. In addition, participants will receive feedback on a text sample of up to 1,000 words.
