



Academic Writing

This workshop is for researchers who wish to publish research articles in English. The aim of this short course is to improve the style and structure of participants' English academic papers and to improve their confidence when writing in English. Participants will have the opportunity to have up to 1,500 words of their text corrected and receive feedback from the instructor. In addition, participants should bring along at least two examples of research articles (written by native English speakers if possible).
