Aims:

- Develop clear, engaging, and confident conference and poster presentations.
- Improve verbal and non-verbal communication skills to connect with audiences.
- Provide personalized coaching to refine delivery and handle Q&A sessions effectively.

Content:

- Finding the story in your talk and structuring presentations for clarity and impact.
- Adapting presentations for international audiences.
- Using rhetorical devices and body language to engage and persuade.
- Managing nervousness and projecting confidence.
- Handling Q&A sessions with ease.
- · Seated and short presentations.

Methods:

- Practical coaching: Delivering a 5–8 minute talk with feedback.
- Interactive discussions on key presentation techniques.
- Individual and group exercises to improve delivery.
- Live coaching and peer feedback on short presentations.
- Practical strategies for managing nerves and engaging audiences.
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- Video analysis for self-reflection and improvement (we don't watch the videos in the course but I will encourage you to watch your video afterwards. People are most often pleasantly surprised at how well they did)
